Elizabeth “Betty” Morris Hamilton was born July 20, 1943, in Birmingham, AL, to Robert Morris and Dennie Mae "Dink" Seale Morris. She passed away at home on May 21, 2023. She was an artist at heart and in practice, teaching hundreds of students across Marshall County and showing her work across the South. She was a graduate of Ensley High School and Auburn University. Betty loved living in Guntersville near the lake but not as much as she loved trips to the beach since she was a teenager. She collected angel figurines and imagery, and was known locally as a retired, occasional B-Team Angel. She was a loving and devoted sister to and preceded in death by Bobby Morris and Gay Raines.
