Byron Miller, 77 of Arab died Thursday December 7, 2023 in Huntsville Hospital. Mr. Miller was born October 11, 1946 in Arab the son of Alton Byron Miller and Berta Lou Allen Miller. He was a graduate of Arab High School, Class of 1965 and a devoted member of Hopewell Missionary Baptist Church, serving as Deacon since 1980. Shortly after his graduation he and the former Joan Black were wed June 9, 1967, sharing 56 years together.
