Rev. Jimmie Henry “J H” Harden, 73 of Arab passed away Sunday, March 11, 2018 in Huntsville Hospital.

Mr. Harden was born in Marshall County February 18, 1945, the son of Henry M and Verna L Abney Harden. He was a high school graduate, and served in the United States Army. He was married to the former Tillie J Cole on July 20, 1973. He had been retired about 9 years from Wayne Farms where he was a utility man for 36 years. He was ordained by Shoal Creek Baptist Church in the mid 70’s and went to Pastor at Beech Springs Baptist Church in Parches Cove.
