John Edward "ED" Bodine, 91 of Arab passed away Friday, June 29, 2018 in Hospice Family Care Facility, Huntsville.

Mr. Bodine was born in Arab, Alabama April 5, 1927, the son of Raymond H and Clara Hood Bodine. He served with Honor and Courage in the United States Army during World War II and was Honorably Discharged as Private First Class. He worked as a truck driver for Commercial Carriage, enjoyed farming, raising cattle and was the owner, operator of Bodine's San/Ann on the Guntersville Highway. The Quilt of Valor seen draping the casket during the visitation and service was presented to John Edward Bodine by the Lakeside Quilters in honor of his military service in World War II.
