Leonard Jackson Jordan, 91 of Arab passed away Sunday June 20, 2021, at Shepherd's Cove Inpatient Hospice Facility.

Mr. Jordan was born September 19, 1929 in Oxford, AL the Son of Herbert and Leona Adams Jordan. He was a graduate of Anniston High School and attended Jacksonville State University. He served in the US Army from 1950-1952, spending a year in Korea. Mr. Jordan worked in appliance businesses in Anniston and Huntsville and later went to work with NASA as a Maintenance Technician and worked in that position until he retired. He was a longtime member and Deacon of Rocky Mount Primitive Baptist Church and also served as the Church Clerk for many years. He was married on April 23, 1952, to the former Irene Blackwood who preceded him in death. He was also preceded in death by his Daughter: Sharon Jordan Leach; Brother: Earl Jordan; Sisters: Betty Rogers and Dorothy Maze. Mr. Jordan married the former Rose Ann Lovett on May 11, 2011.
