Mary Anne Moore Freeman, born Feb. 6, 1931, died Sat. March 2, 2019, in Marietta, GA. She was preceded in death by her beloved Husband, Lamar Freeman and Parents, Ethredge Moore and Bernice Richeson Moore. She earned a BS Degree from the University of Alabama's School of Commerce and Business Administration in 1953. At a time when few women competed in business, she progressed from advertising sales to advertising manager and finally publisher at newspapers in Florida, Georgia and Alabama. She spent the last twenty years of her career as a marketing executive, ending as area marketing director for three north Alabama hospitals.
