



## Rex Evers

October 11, 1927 - January 12, 2014

Rex L. Evers, age 86, of Arab died January 12, 2014 at his residence. Mr. Evers was preceded in death by his wife of 54 years, Bobbie Sue McGuire Evers, his parents, Daniel Evers and Sally Evers; brothers, Gordy Evers, Robie Evers, and Doyle Evers; sisters, Iris Evers Roberts, Verba Evers Hodges, Roxie Evers Hall, and Claris Evers; and grandson Chad McGuire Evers.

He is survived by sons, David Evers (Lynn) of Tuscaloosa, Randy Evers (Pam) of Arab, Mark Evers (Becky) of Franklin Tennessee, daughter, Susan Nixon (Randy) of Arab, grandchildren Justin Evers (Lauren), Tina Hill (Jason), Andrea Mercer (Mike), Dylan Evers, Amy Nixon, Devin Evers, Graham Evers, Curtis Evers, Marina Evers and seven great grandchildren.

Mr. Evers served in the U.S. Navy during WW II. After the war, he studied photography in Gadsden. He was a photographer for the Department of the Army on Redstone Arsenal, 1956 - 1987. During that time, it was his great privilege to photograph presidents' Dwight Eisenhower, John F. Kennedy, Lyndon B. Johnson, and Richard Nixon, as well as the world renowned Werner von Braun.

For many years Mr. Evers and his wife Bobbie operated a photography studio in Arab. They documented countless weddings, birthdays, reunions, graduations, beauty pageants, ball teams, and family events with cherished photographs.

He was a member of Arab First Baptist Church where he served faithfully as a

Deacon.

The family will receive guests from 12:00 until 2:00 Tues. Jan. 14th, 2014, at Arab First Baptist followed by a Funeral Service at 2:00.
