Sara M. "Sally" Cox age 82, of Albertville formerly of Arab passed away Sunday November 2, 2014, at Shepherd's Cove. Mrs. Cox was born on June 29, 1932, in Oneonta, AL to L.D. and Marie O. McDonald.
