Willard Evans age 85, Arab, passed away Tuesday, April 28, 2015 at Marshall Medical Center North. He was born September 15, 1929 to Delmas and Mozelle Jones Evans in Grassy, AL. He graduated from Arab High School and then served 2 years in the Army. He graduated from Athens College and then served 35 years in the National Guard, retiring as a Lt. Colonel.
